A Ray of Hope For Over 50 Years

The Friends of NorthKey ("The Friends") has been proudly serving the needs of NorthKey Community Care ("NorthKey") clients since 1970, and is a 501(c)(3), non-profit organization.

In 2024, NorthKey served over 17,000 clients in the Northern Kentucky area. In 2024, that number will continue to grow as NorthKey continues to provide quality mental health, substance use, and development disabilities services to meet the needs of the Northern Kentucky community.

## What was purchased with the proceeds from The Friends of NorthKey's Virtual Event last year?

- Homelessness Program—\$ 5500 tents, blankets, pocket calendars, backpacks and clothing, including coats, socks, shirts, pants, and shoes.
- Child Case Management and Early Childhood Programs— A Halloween and Christmas Parade were held for 200 NorthKey child clients and their families. The Friends donated \$12,864 in Christmas gifts for these clients and families.
- Michelle P. Waiver Program—Emergency groceries and household items were purchased for many clients involved in the Michelle P. Waiver program.
- Adult Day Training Prorams—\$2,500 for various learning activities, holiday gifts and parties and awards day gifts and pizza parties for both our Grant and Falmouth locations.
- <u>Child Case Management Families</u>—Christmas turkey/hams were purchased for the families participating in child case management services.
- Scholarships—The Friends awarded a total amount of \$10,000 in scholarships to six NorthKey clients to further their education.
